- HCR 1020 (HJ 24th LD; Deferred from 25th LD) Recognizing the 22nd anniversary of the Khojaly tragedy which resulted in the loss of over six hundred lives.
- HCR 1022 (HJ 25th LD) Concerning U.S. EPA-proposed greenhouse gas emission standards for new and existing fossil-fueled power plants.
- HCR 1023 (HJ 25th LD) Rejecting the Common Core State Standards plan.
- HCR 1024 (HJ 25th LD) Petitioning President Obama to publicly condemn China for its aggressive program of cyber warfare and espionage against the United States of America.

HB 1194* (Deferred from 25th LD) establish certain requirements relating to the crossings of railroad rights-of-way by utilities.

- HB 1038 (Deferred from 25th LD) authorize the Department of Public Safety to build a highway patrol office and motorcycle training facility in Rapid City, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1203 (Deferred from 25th LD) improve the financial practices of the State of South Dakota.
- HB 1215 (Placed by Motion; Deferred from 25th LD) provide for the issuance of free fishing licenses to residents aged eighty-five and older.
- HB 1208* restrict certain activities on waters that inundate private property.
- HB 1040* revise the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2014.
- HB 1112* appropriate general funds and higher education facility funds to replace a portion of the other funds appropriated for the construction of swine teaching and research facilities at South Dakota State University and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1175* authorize the Board of Regents to expand university facilities at the University of South Dakota, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1145 accommodate legislation on medical services.
- HB 1146 accommodate legislation relating to education in South Dakota.
- HB 1236 establish the school innovation and emergency fund.
- HB 1075 provide for public notice of certain hearings conducted by the Board of Education, and to require that the hearings be conducted at least sixty days apart.
- HB 1165* adopt the Uniform Deployed Parents Custody and Visitation Act.

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 12 (Deferred from 25th LD) update references to certain federal motor carrier regulations.
- SB 64 (Deferred from 25th LD) require a waiting period prior to the adoption of new uniform content standards and to provide for an opportunity for public comment for all new content standards.
- SB 55 (Deferred from 25th LD) repeal the contractor's excise tax on certain new or expanded power production facilities.
- SB 27 (Deferred from 25th LD) make an appropriation from the coordinated natural resources conservation fund to the State Conservation Commission and to declare an emergency.
- SB 31 (Deferred from 25th LD) make an appropriation to reimburse certain family physicians who have complied with the requirements of the recruitment assistance program and to declare an emergency.
- SB 32 (Deferred from 25th LD) revise previous appropriations for National Guard armory construction, to make an appropriation for a land purchase adjacent to the Watertown armory, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 63* (Deferred from 25th LD) protect the privacy of the records of individual students.
- SB 14 (Deferred from 25th LD) revise certain provisions pertaining to the Board of Examiners of Counselors and Marriage and Family Therapists.
- SB 89 (Deferred from 25th LD) repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding the medical department of the National Guard.
- SB 93 (Deferred from 25th LD) define liquid natural gas, to revise certain provisions regarding the collection of the motor fuel tax, and to apply motor fuel tax to all fuels used to propel a motor vehicle.

- SB 103* (Deferred from 25th LD) establish certain civil penalties for tampering or removing any highway marker, sign, or control device and to distribute the revenue from such civil penalties.
- SB 29* (Deferred from 25th LD) revise certain provisions in statute and administrative rules regarding the regulation of campgrounds and the license fee for campgrounds and to repeal administrative rules regulating primitive campgrounds, full-service campgrounds, limited service campgrounds, and temporary campgrounds.
- SB 54* (Deferred from 25th LD) revise the definition of a boat dealer, used vehicle dealer, and dealer of mobile homes or manufactured homes, and to revise certain penalties for selling motor vehicles, snowmobiles, mobile homes, manufactured homes, or boats without a license.
- SB 59 (Deferred from 25th LD) increase the penalty for the trafficking of vehicle license plates and decals, to prohibit and provide a penalty for the unauthorized transfer of a vehicle license plate or decal, and to impose a penalty for altering or forging certain vehicle registration cards.
