CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEES

- SB 65            revise and clarify voter eligibility for road district elections.
- HB 1111        revise certain provisions related to the design, construction, and equipping of a veterans home near Hot Springs and to make an appropriation therefor.
- HB 1142        enhance the support for public postsecondary technical institutes, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1213        analyze and promote economic development for South Dakota's Native American population and to establish a task force.

CONFERENCE COMMITTEES APPOINTED THAT HAVE NOT REPORTED

- HB 1177        restrict the regulation by local governments related to use of electronic wireless communication devices in motor vehicles, to prohibit the use of certain handheld electronic wireless communication devices, and to provide a penalty therefor.
