SB 68 adopt the uniform real property electronic recording act, to use an existing funding source to implement the provisions of this Act, and to revise certain provisions concerning electronic recording.

SB 82 revise certain provisions concerning purchases, sales, and contracts made by public officers with the state or its political subdivisions.

SB 95 revise certain vehicle dealer licensing provisions.

HB 1044 authorize limited cosmetology services outside of a licensed salon or booth.

HB 1047* revise various trust and trust company provisions.

HB 1057 repeal certain provisions imposing the inheritance tax and the estate tax.

- HB 1061 (Removed from Consent Calendar) include limited liability companies in certain provisions regarding the licensing of boats and motor vehicles and certain provisions regarding the dealers and manufacturers of certain vehicles, manufactured homes, and mobile homes.
- HB 1046 (Deferred from 14th LD) revise certain provisions regarding licenses issued by the State Plumbing Commission and the fees that may be set by the commission.
- HB 1049 (Deferred from 14th LD) establish and revise certain provisions regarding the South Dakota Athletic Commission.
- HB 1025* revise certain statutes and administrative rules regarding licensure of nursing facility administrators and to increase certain fees.
- HB 1070 sunset certain tax refund claims for an economic development incentive program that has been previously terminated and to declare an emergency.
