HCR 1017 (HJ p 336) Urging Congress, the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP), the United States Department of Justice, and the United States Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) to recognize industrial hemp as a valuable agricultural commodity.

HCR 1018 (HJ p 393) Recognizing Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) as a serious and chronic disease in South Dakota.

HCR 1019* (HJ p 395) Petitioning Congress to reauthorize federally provided terrorism reinsurance for insurers.

- SB 19* increase expenditure authority to accommodate donations to projects at Black Hills State University and Northern State University, to authorize the acquisition and renovation of improved real property for a project at Dakota State University, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 90* revise certain provisions related to the High School Activities Association.
- SB 81* prohibit the possession of certain items in jails, to provide a penalty therefor, and to revise the penalty for the procurement of certain items into a jail.
- SB 180* authorize the increase in the number of video lottery machines that may placed in a licensed establishment under certain conditions.
- SB 170 revise the structure for compensating surface owners for losses due to mineral development.
