SB 162\* (Intent to reconsider vote by which passed) repeal certain mineral severance taxes imposed on precious metals and to repeal certain temporary and expired mineral severance taxes.

HCR 1012 (HJ p 291) Recognizing the honor and remember flag as the designated symbol of South Dakota's concern and commitment to honoring and remembering all members of the United States Armed Forces who have lost their lives while serving, or as a result of service, and their families.

- SB 116\* (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) deposit certain abandoned property into the building South Dakota fund.
- SB 172\* (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) revise certain provisions relating to services performed by dental hygienists.
- SB 19\* (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) increase expenditure authority to accommodate donations to projects at Black Hills State University and Northern State University, to authorize the acquisition and renovation of improved real property for a project at Dakota State University, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 170 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) revise the structure for compensating surface owners for losses due to mineral development.
- SB 164\* revise the allocation of certain temporary nonresident waterfowl hunting licenses.
- SB 69\* revise certain provisions regarding good cause for voluntarily leaving employment.
- SB 161\* revise certain provisions relating to notice provided by mineral developers.
- SB 1 provide for the selection of the chair and vice chair of the Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council, to provide for the year-round governance of the Legislative Research Council by the Executive Board, to provide for the term of each constituted Executive Board, and to provide for continuity of board membership.
- SB 13 make use of hand-held mobile telephones while driving a commercial motor vehicle a serious traffic violation and to update certain references to federal regulations regarding the issuance of commercial driver licenses.
- SJR 2 Proposing and submitting to the electors at the next general election an amendment to Article XII of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to the creation and administration of a trust fund for the purpose of certain energy mineral taxes.

- HB 1029 (Deferred from 22<sup>nd</sup> LD) revise certain requirements regarding the Richard Hagen-Minerva Harvey memorial scholarship program.
