HB 1031 revise certain provisions related to the definition of and the diagnosing of autism and to revise the definition of a level five disability for purposes of state aid for special education funding.
- HB 1130* authorize the use of crossbows for hunting big game animals during the firearm season.
- HB 1107 repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding restraint of trade.
HB 1131 clarify that a credit card is not required to establish a revolving credit account.

- SB 116* (Deferred from 23rd LD) deposit certain abandoned property into the building South Dakota fund.
- SB 170 (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise the structure for compensating surface owners for losses due to mineral development.
- SB 99* revise certain provisions regarding self-funded multiple employer trusts.
- SB 176* revise certain provisions concerning the tax relief fund.
- SB 179* prohibit the use of certain handheld electronic wireless devices for electronic messaging while driving and to allow conflicting local ordinances.
- SB 38 revise the state aid to special education formula.
- SB 152 make an appropriation to provide full funding of the cement plant retirement plan, to consolidate the cement plant retirement plan with the South Dakota Retirement System, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 102 provide that, upon completion of certain proceedings, magistrate judges may return or dispose of property taken in as evidence.

- HB 1015 (Deferred from 23rd LD) create an equitable process to handle water right applications submitted for aquifers determined to be fully appropriated by the Water Management Board.
