MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- SB 7* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ p 600, 654) modify the persons eligible for protection from domestic abuse and to revise certain terminology.
- SB 183* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ p 589, 658) revise the trust fund requirements for perpetual cemeteries, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 2* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ p 599, 653) provide for the delayed arrest, under certain circumstances, in regard to certain outstanding warrants for victims of domestic abuse with minor children.
- SB 3* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ p 600, 654) provide for continuity in the judicial review of certain lawsuits, complaints, and petitions between parties to a petition for certain protection orders.
- SB 163* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ p 604, 655) prohibit a social host from permitting the underage consumption of alcoholic beverages on the social host's premises and to provide penalties therefor.
- SCR 6* (SJ 32nd LD) Expressing the Legislature's support for citizens and communities in eastern South Dakota impacted by severe high water conditions over the last two decades.
- HCR 1028* (HJ p 525) Urging Congress to repeal and defund the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

- HB 1177* restrict the regulation by local governments of distracted or inattentive driving, to prohibit the use of certain handheld electronic wireless communication devices, and to provide a penalty therefor.
- HB 1175* authorize the Board of Regents to expand university facilities at the University of South Dakota, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1071 change the procedure for a minor boundary change.
- HB 1127* provide an exemption for alimony payments in debtor filings.
- HB 1161* establish a cause of action for wrongful human trafficking.
- HB 1169* protect certain homestead exemption interests during sale of homestead or separation of owners.
- HB 1166* revise the telecommunications services program to include current and developing technology.
- HB 1143* (Deferred from 32nd LD) repeal certain provisions regarding unemployment insurance benefit eligibility of workers attending approved training.
- HB 1025* (Deferred from 32nd LD) revise certain statutes and administrative rules regarding licensure of nursing facility administrators and to increase certain fees.
- HB 1046 (Deferred from 32nd LD) revise certain provisions regarding licenses issued by the State Plumbing Commission and the fees that may be set by the commission.
- HB 1038 (Deferred from 32nd LD) authorize the Department of Public Safety to build a highway patrol office and motorcycle training facility in Rapid City, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1206* (Deferred from 32nd LD) authorize the payment of lease rental obligations to the South Dakota Building Authority by the Bureau of Finance and Management, to make an appropriation therefore, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1129* (Deferred from 32nd LD) prohibit the use of certain explosive targets in the Black Hills Forest Fire Protection District.
- HB 1164* (Deferred from 32nd LD) revise certain provisions regarding school board opening day decision petitions.
- HB 1213* (Deferred from 32nd LD) analyze and promote economic development for South Dakota's Native American population and to establish a task force.
- HB 1045 (Deferred from 32nd LD) revise unemployment insurance contribution rates.
- HB 1019* (Deferred from 32nd LD) provide certain provisions regarding the requirements for postsecondary institutions to participate in a multistate state authorization reciprocity agreement for distance education activities.
- HB 1099 (Deferred from 32nd LD) revise the membership of the State Investment Council.
- HB 1148 (Deferred from 32nd LD) provide a license for certain businesses to allow patrons to manufacture malt beverages and wines on the licensed premises for personal use.
- HB 1111 (Deferred from 32nd LD) revise certain provisions related to the design, construction, and equipping of a veterans home near Hot Springs, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1112* (Deferred from 32nd LD) appropriate general funds and higher education facility funds to replace a portion of the other funds appropriated for the construction of swine teaching and research facilities at South Dakota State University and to declare an emergency.
