- HB 1122\* define the limitations of interstate compacts relating to the collection of civil fines.
- HB 1040\* revise the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2014.
- HB 1085 revise certain property tax levies for the general fund of school districts.
- HB 1145 accommodate legislation on medical services.
- HB 1194\* establish certain requirements relating to the crossings of railroad rights-of-way by utilities.
- HB 1203\* improve the financial practices of the State of South Dakota.
- HB 1041\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) make an appropriation for the railroad trust fund and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1142\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) enhance the support for public postsecondary technical institutes, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.

- HB 1206\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) authorize the payment of lease rental obligations to the South Dakota Building Authority by the Bureau of Finance and Management, to make an appropriation therefore, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1164\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) revise certain provisions regarding school board opening day decision petitions.
- HB 1213\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) analyze and promote economic development for South Dakota's Native American population and to establish a task force.
- HB 1045 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) revise unemployment insurance contribution rates.
- HB 1019\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) provide certain provisions regarding the requirements for postsecondary institutions to participate in a multistate state authorization reciprocity agreement for distance education activities.

- HB 1099 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) revise the membership of the State Investment Council.
- HB 1148 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) provide a license for certain businesses to allow patrons to manufacture malt beverages and wines on the licensed premises for personal use.
- HB 1111 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) revise certain provisions related to the design, construction, and equipping of a veterans home near Hot Springs, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1112\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) appropriate general funds and higher education facility funds to replace a portion of the other funds appropriated for the construction of swine teaching and research facilities at South Dakota State University and to declare an emergency.
