MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

\*Amended

- SB 1\* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ 642, 685) provide for the selection of the chair and vice chair of the Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council, to revise the membership of the Executive Board, to provide for the term of each constituted Executive Board, and to provide for continuity of board membership.
- SB 23\* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ 645, 685) revise certain provisions relating to deceptive trade practices, including unordered property or services, lodging reservation and cancellation, violation penalties, attorney's fees, entry rights for landlords and tenants, debit card theft, and organized retail crime.
- SB 25\* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ 645, 686) establish the procedure to forfeit personal property in child pornography, human trafficking, child solicitation or exploitation cases, and to direct money from the forfeitures..
- SB 99\* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ 646, 681) revise certain provisions regarding self-funded multiple employer trusts.
- SB 176\* (Consideration of House Amendment, HJ 625, 688) revise the ability of the secretary of the Department of Revenue to reduce or abate taxes.

CONFERENCE COMMITTEES APPOINTED THAT HAVE NOT REPORTED

\*Amended

HB 1177\* restrict the regulation by local governments related to use of electronic wireless communication devices in motor vehicles, to prohibit the use of certain handheld electronic wireless communication devices, and to provide a penalty therefor.
