## HOUSE BILL NO. 1014

Introduced by: The Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources at the request of the  
Department of Environment and Natural Resources

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain obsolete and unnecessary statutes relating  
2 to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 34A-6-23 be repealed.

5 ~~34A-6-23. All municipalities shall develop and submit to the board for approval on a~~  
6 ~~specified date a plan to provide a solid waste management system and shall provide for the~~  
7 ~~disposal of solid wastes generated or existing within the incorporated limits of such municipality~~  
8 ~~or in the area to be served thereby without harmful effects to the inhabitants.~~

9 Section 2. That § 45-2-4.1 be repealed.

10 ~~45-2-4.1. For the purposes of this chapter, the state geologist shall cooperate with and be~~  
11 ~~under the direction of the Governor.~~

12 Section 3. That § 46A-1-9 be repealed.

13 ~~46A-1-9. The Board of Water and Natural Resources shall continuously review the~~  
14 ~~development and progress on the comprehensive statewide water plan as it is prepared as~~  
15 ~~provided by § 46A-2-2. The plan when completed shall include a list of rivers or sections of~~



1 ~~rivers which may be designated as wild, scenic, or recreational rivers.~~

2 Section 4. That § 46A-1-16 be repealed.

3 ~~—46A-1-16. Some of the free-flowing streams and rivers of South Dakota possess such unique~~  
4 ~~natural scenic beauty, water conservation, fish, wildlife, and outdoor recreational values of~~  
5 ~~present and future benefit to the people of the state that it is hereby declared that the Board of~~  
6 ~~Water and Natural Resources has a policy to recommend to preserve these areas for the benefit~~  
7 ~~of the people of South Dakota. For this purpose there shall be designated certain "wild, scenic,~~  
8 ~~and recreational river areas" to be preserved as a part of South Dakota's diminishing resource~~  
9 ~~of free-flowing rivers and streams.~~

10 Section 5. That § 46A-16-2 be repealed.

11 ~~—46A-16-2. The South Dakota-Minnesota Boundary Waters Commission shall continue~~  
12 ~~within the office of the Governor, and shall retain all its prescribed functions, including~~  
13 ~~administrative functions. The commission shall submit such records, information, and reports~~  
14 ~~in the form and at such times as required by the Governor, except that the commission shall~~  
15 ~~report at least annually.~~
