HOUSE BILL NO. 1042

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of Public Safety

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Department of Public Safety to construct
2 offices in Butte County and Roberts County, to make an appropriation therefor, and to
3 declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. The Department of Public Safety may contract for the construction, completion,
6 placement, furnishing, equipping, and maintaining of, including heating, plumbing, water,
7 sewer, electric facilities, architectural and engineering services, and such other services or
8 actions as may be required to construct offices, to be located on the Department of
9 Transportation lots or in the immediate vicinity, in Butte County and Roberts County, South
10 Dakota.

11 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated the sum of one hundred ninety-six thousand eight
12 hundred fifty dollars (\$196,850) in other fund expenditure authority, or so much thereof as may
13 be necessary, to the Department of Public Safety to construct the facilities described in section
14 1 of this Act.

15 Section 3. The Bureau of Administration, pursuant to § 5-14-2, shall supervise the design,



1 renovation, and construction of the facilities approved by this Act. The commissioner of the
2 Bureau of Administration and the secretary of public safety shall approve vouchers and the state
3 auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

4 Section 4. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
5 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

6 Section 5. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
7 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
8 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
