1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require a sex offender to report a change in vehicle status
2 to law enforcement.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 22-24B be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 A sex offender shall report, within three business days, any change in the registration status
7 of a vehicle the offender owns, to the authority specified in § 22-24B-2. A violation of this
8 section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
