HOUSE BILL NO. 1127

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt the state from daylight savings time.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That chapter 1-5 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
4 follows:

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary by the United States relating to
6 the adoption of daylight savings time by all of the states, the state of South Dakota elects to
7 reject daylight savings time and elects to continue use in force standard time, or summer hours.

8 The provisions of this section may not be construed to affect the standard time established
9 by the United States law governing the movements of common carriers engaged in interstate
10 commerce or the time for performance of an act by an officer or department of the United States,
11 as established by statute, lawful order, rule, or regulation of the United States or an agency
12 thereof.
