- HB 1018 (Deferred from 8th LD) revise the sales and use tax exemptions for farm machinery.
HB 1012 (Deferred from 8th LD) revise certain provisions regarding child welfare agencies.
HB 1013* revise certain provisions related to social work licensure.
HB 1020* revise the mailing fees for noncommercial vehicle plates and decals.
HB 1051 revise various trust and trust company provisions.
HB 1021 repeal the authorization for the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology research center project and to authorize the South Dakota Building Authority to issue bonds to finance a portion of the maintenance and repair of the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology chemistry/chemical engineering renovation project.
HB 1022 authorize the Board of Regents to purchase improved property in Spearfish and to make an appropriation therefor.
HB 1042 authorize the Department of Public Safety to construct offices in Butte County and Roberts County, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
HB 1049 repeal certain provisions regarding reversions of appropriations for a repealed tax refund program.
HB 1060 make an appropriation to reimburse certain family physicians, dentists, physician assistants, and nurse practitioners who have complied with the requirements of the recruitment assistance program and to declare an emergency.
HB 1063 revise the notice provisions for the name change of a minor child.
HB 1037 revise certain provisions related to the regulation of public utilities.

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 28 (Deferred from 8th LD) authorize the Board of Regents to sell certain extraneous real property to the City of Brookings, to deposit the proceeds in the school and public lands trust for the benefit of South Dakota State University, and to declare an emergency.
