- SCR 2 (SJ 10th LD) endorsing the thirty-first anniversary of sister state relations with the Republic of China (Taiwan), Taiwan's inclusion in the Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP) and Taiwan's participation as an observer in the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO).
- SCR 3 (SJ 10th LD) Recognizing the mutual benefit between health care sharing and health savings accounts.

- HB 1052* revise certain provisions regarding the regulation of insurance holding companies.
- HB 1091 require that the minutes of meetings of any state board or commission include a record of how each individual member voted on certain motions.
- HB 1106 establish the rights of municipal, county, or township officers in certain decision-making processes.
- HB 1079 revise the deadline for the Department of Health's annual report regarding abortions.
- HB 1080 authorize the use of investigational treatments for patients under certain conditions and to restrict certain causes of action arising from investigational treatment.

- SB 61 place certain substances on the controlled substances schedule and to declare an emergency.
