Amended HJ 18<sup>th</sup> LD: HB 1072, HB 1236, HB 1173

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1148 require that the annual report of a school district contain certain information regarding school district fund balances.
- HB 1178 provide for the creation of an entity for the purpose of insurance contracts in certain instances.
- HB 1142 revise certain provisions pertaining to the age requirements for sex offender registry registration.

- HB 1179 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) revise the definition of a veteran.
- HB 1188\* make an appropriation to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources to develop a hydrologic model of the lower Big Sioux River Basin in southeast South Dakota and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1191\* make an appropriation for the jobs for America's graduates program and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1192\* make an appropriation for the protection and enhancement of wildlife habitat and to declare an emergency.

- HB 1094\* revise certain provisions regarding the annual minimum wage adjustment.
- HB 1105\* provide for an affidavit creating a rebuttable presumption that a person is not an employee for purposes of workers' compensation and to provide a penalty therefor.
- HB 1116 repeal and revise certain provisions relating to the requirements for a permit to carry a concealed pistol.
- HB 1195 declare void the transgender policy of the South Dakota High School Activities Association and to establish a determinant in identifying a student's sexual identity for the purpose of participation in high school athletics.
- HJR 1002 making a formal application to the President of the United States, that the President grant a presidential pardon to Peter L. Larson.
- HB 1180 revise certain provisions regarding the regulation of captive insurance companies.

## SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 61 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) place certain substances on the controlled substances schedule and to declare an emergency.
- SB 34\* (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) revise certain provisions concerning the administration of benefits provided to veterans and to declare an emergency.
- SB 14\* (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) provide for the possession and administration of opioid antagonists by first responders for the treatment of drug overdoses.
- SB 15 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) allow for discretionary appeals of illegal sentences.
- SB 18\* (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) establish certain administrative provisions regarding charitable raffles, lotteries, and bingo and to make violations of these provisions subject to the Deceptive Trade Practice and Consumer Protection Act.
- SB 46 (Deferred from 18<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation of other fund expenditure authority to the Department of Agriculture for the construction of the Nordby Exhibit Hall at the South Dakota State Fair and to declare an emergency.
- SB 43\* revise certain provisions regarding lease purchase agreement payments and to ratify certain lease purchase agreements with the Health and Educational Facilities Authority.
