Amended HJ 19<sup>th</sup> LD: HB 1194, HB 1030

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

\* Amended

- HB 1090 prohibit a person from serving as a member of a consumers power district board of directors in certain cases.
- SB 77\* allow nursing mothers to breastfeed in certain locations.
- SB 16 revise certain provisions safeguarding law enforcement radio communications.
- SB 22 revise the penalty for altering a registration device issued by a dealer.
- SB 40 revise certain provisions regarding the federal motor carrier regulations.

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1148 (Removed from Consent Calendar) require that the annual report of a school district contain certain information regarding school district fund balances.
- HB 1105\* (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD) provide for an affidavit creating a rebuttable presumption that a person is not an employee for purposes of workers' compensation and to provide a penalty therefor.
- HB 1072\* provide that certain information regarding postsecondary technical institutes be given to parents and guardians of students in middle schools and high schools.

- HB 1236\* revise certain provisions regarding commissions received by insurance producers.  
HB 1173\* ~~deter certain frivolous appeals of land zoning decisions.~~  
Revise certain provisions regarding liability of parties involved in frivolous or malicious civil actions.
- HB 1216 repeal the limitation on the total amount of revenue payable from taxes on real property for all taxing districts, except school districts.

- SB 43\* (Deferred from 19<sup>th</sup> LD)) revise certain provisions regarding lease purchase agreement payments and to ratify certain lease purchase agreements with the Health and Educational Facilities Authority.
- SB 75\* revise the effective period of the travel permit for certain livestock used for rodeo purposes and to declare an emergency.
- SB 76 extend the length of time a local livestock ownership inspection certificate is valid for transportation.
