

- SB 10 revise certain provisions concerning the classes of investments used for state funds.
SB 29 establish provisions for auxiliary members to serve on the Board of Pardons and Paroles.
- SB 38 revise certain provisions concerning the state communications system and the South Dakota law enforcement telecommunications system.
- SB 90 require school districts to provide veterans a preference in employment.
SB 80 increase the selling price of a towed vehicle that exempts the seller of the vehicle from certain vehicle dealer licensing requirements.

- SB 43* (Deferred from 27th LD) revise certain provisions regarding lease purchase agreement payments and to ratify certain lease purchase agreements with the Health and Educational Facilities Authority.
