MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1027* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 444) revise certain provisions regarding the regulation of certain money lending activities.
- HB 1079* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 471) revise the deadline for the Department of Health's annual report regarding abortions.
- HB 1130* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 366) prohibit an abortion provider from accepting payment for an abortion prior to the end of the required informed consent period.
- HB 1146* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 488) limit who may request to see a person's hunting or fishing license.
- HB 1148* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 487) require that the annual report of a school district contain certain information regarding school district fund balances.
- HB 1236* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 486) revise certain provisions regarding commissions received by insurance producers.
- SCR 8 (SJ 27th LD) Condemning the growing anti-Semitism in certain countries and extending an invitation to Jewish families from around the world to South Dakota.

- SB 41 (Deferred from 29th LD) revise certain provisions pertaining to commercial driver licensing.

- SB 89* (Deferred from 29th LD) require the development of school safety plans and to require the conduct of lockdown drills in accredited schools.

- SB 81 (Deferred from 29th LD) require persons convicted of driving a vehicle while under influence of alcohol, drugs, or intoxicants to pay certain costs to the county.

- SB 25 authorize the Board of Regents to enter into a lease-purchase agreement to acquire agricultural property in Moody County for the use and benefit of the South Dakota State University Agricultural Experiment Station.
- SB 26 authorize the Board of Regents to demolish the veterinary isolation building on the campus of South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.
- SB 27* authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the replacement of the plant science research support facility on the campus of South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.

- SB 110 revise the authority granted to the Building Authority and to the Board of Regents to construct an information system building on the campus of Dakota State University in Madison.
