

- SB 37 adopt the 2008 Uniform Interstate Family Support Act, to repeal the 1996 Uniform Interstate Family Support Act, and to revise certain provisions relating thereto.
- HB 1036 codify legislation enacted in 2014.
- HB 1024 repeal certain outdated and unnecessary statutes related to the Department of Labor and Regulation.
- HB 1025 revise certain provisions regarding banks and banking.
- HB 1028 revise certain provisions regarding money transmitters and money transmissions.

- SB 69* revise certain provisions regarding elections and election petitions.
- SB 71 (Deferred from 12th LD) continue the Jolene's Law Task Force for an additional year, revise the membership of the task force, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 70* require that the mandatory reporter who witnessed the disclosure or evidence of child abuse or neglect be available to answer questions when the initial report is made.
- SB 82 update outdated language related to domestic abuse.
- SB 76 extend the length of time a local livestock ownership inspection certificate is valid for transportation.
- SB 89 require the development of school safety plans and to require the conduct of lockdown drills in accredited schools.
- SB 67 (Deferred from 12th LD) revise certain provisions regarding challenges to certain election petition signatures.
- SB 66* (Deferred from 12th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the county renaming process.
- SB 39 (Deferred from 12th LD) make an appropriation for costs related to disasters in the state and to declare an emergency.
