MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HCR 1004 (Deferred from 14th LD) (HJ p 144) Addressed to the United States Supreme Court setting forth certain facts and expressly enumerating the grievances of the People of the State of South Dakota, through their elected representatives, with that Court's decision in Roe v. Wade, 410 U.S. 113 (1973), and its progeny and calling for that Court to now protect the intrinsic, natural, fundamental rights of the children of our State and nation and the intrinsic, natural, fundamental rights of their pregnant mothers in their relationship with their children, and the mothers' health by reconsidering and overturning the court's decision in Roe.

SB 161* allow certain fireworks to be used all year.

SB 80 increase the selling price of a towed vehicle that exempts the seller of the vehicle from certain vehicle dealer licensing requirements.

- SB 85 repeal certain requirements regarding the handlebar height on motorcycles.
SB 94 establish a license fee for electric-powered motorcycles.
SB 111 repeal the provision that invalidates absentee ballots cast by voters who died before the date of the election.
SB 100 create a leased residential property classification and to establish the school district general fund levy for the property classification.
SB 57 authorize and regulate the playing of craps, roulette, and keno within the city limits of the city of Deadwood.
SB 66* (Deferred from 15th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the county renaming process.
SB 39 (Deferred from 15th LD) make an appropriation for costs related to disasters in the state and to declare an emergency.

HB 1063 (Deferred from 15th LD) revise the notice provisions for the name change of a minor child.
HB 1043* (Deferred from 15th LD) repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding the Department of Education.
HB 1057* (Deferred from 15th LD) make an appropriation to reimburse certain eligible health care professionals who have complied with the requirements of the rural health care facility recruitment assistance program and to declare an emergency.
HB 1051 (Deferred from 15th LD) revise various trust and trust company provisions.
HB 1013* (Deferred from 15th LD) revise certain provisions related to social work licensure.
