- HB 1059* (Deferred from 19th LD) allow authorized entities to access immunization information in certain circumstances.
- HB 1063 (Deferred from 19th LD) revise the notice provisions for the name change of a minor child.
- HB 1043* (Deferred from 19th LD) repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding the Department of Education.
