- HB 1081* repeal certain provisions regarding county officials and the board of county commissioners.
- HB 1080* authorize the use of investigational treatments for patients under certain conditions and to restrict certain causes of action arising from investigational treatment.
- HB 1089 ban the practice of female genital mutilation in the state, to provide a penalty therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1130* (Deferred from 23rd LD) prohibit an abortion provider from accepting payment for an abortion prior to the end of the required informed consent period.
- HB 1085 (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise certain provisions regarding the requirement for performance securities.
- HB 1055* (Deferred from 23rd LD) repeal certain outdated and unnecessary statutes and administrative rules related to the Department of Agriculture.
- HB 1058* (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise certain provisions regarding contagious disease control quarantine measures.
- HB 1059* (Deferred from 23rd LD) allow authorized entities to access immunization information in certain circumstances.
- HB 1063 (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise the notice provisions for the name change of a minor child.
- HB 1043* (Deferred from 23rd LD) repeal certain outdated and obsolete provisions regarding the Department of Education.
- HB 1057* (Deferred from 23rd LD) make an appropriation to reimburse certain eligible health care professionals who have complied with the requirements of the rural health care facility recruitment assistance program and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1051 (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise various trust and trust company provisions.
- HB 1013* (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise certain provisions related to social work licensure.
