HCR 1008 (Deferred from 29th LD) (HJ p 493) Urging Congress and the President to recognize tribal identification cards as a valid form of identification for all official purposes.

HCR 1009 (HJ p 512) Designating 2015 as the "Year of Remembrance for the Centennial Since the Commencement of the Armenian Genocide of 1915-1923" in South Dakota and urging Congress and the President of the United States to formally and consistently recognize and reaffirm the historical truth that the atrocities committed against the Armenian, Greek, and other Christians living in their historical homelands in Anatolia constituted genocide and to work towards equitable, stable, and durable Armenian-Turkish relations and a fair, just, and comprehensive international resolution of this crime against humanity.

- HB 1139* revise certain procedures for competitive sealed bids by public purchasing agencies.
HB 1165 revise the composition requirement of the Historic Preservation Commission.
HB 1031 repeal certain provisions regarding former state-owned rail lines.
HB 1064* prohibit unlawful self-dealing by state officers and employees.
HB 1144 repeal and revise certain unnecessary and outdated provisions related to state affairs and government.

- HB 1002* make an appropriation to the Department of Revenue to provide for the electronic submission of reports and taxes related to alcoholic beverages and to declare an emergency.
HB 1042 authorize the Department of Public Safety to construct offices in Butte County and Roberts County, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
HB 1047* revise certain reversion provisions relating to the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2013.
HB 1048 revise certain provisions regarding state hosting and employee reimbursement policies.
HB 1050 repeal certain funds, to make revisions to receipts dedicated to the property tax reduction fund, and to create the general revenue replacement fund.
HB 1030* provide certain restrictions regarding the passing of a bicycle.
HB 1124* authorize motor vehicles to exceed the posted speed limit under certain conditions.
HB 1177* remove certain exceptions to campaign finance report filings.
HB 1072* (Deferred from 29th LD) provide that certain information regarding postsecondary technical institutes be given to parents and guardians of students in middle schools and high schools.
HB 1073* (Deferred from 29th LD) require a sex offender to report a change in vehicle status to law enforcement.
HB 1128* (Deferred from 29th LD) protect certain homestead exemption interests during sale of homestead or separation of owners.
HB 1134 revise certain provisions concerning the expungement of arrest records.
HB 1013* (Deferred from 29th LD) revise certain provisions related to social work licensure.
HB 1080* (Deferred from 29th LD) authorize the use of investigational treatments for patients under certain conditions and to restrict certain causes of action arising from investigational treatment.
HB 1058* (Deferred from 29th LD) revise certain provisions regarding contagious disease control quarantine measures.
HB 1059* (Deferred from 29th LD) allow authorized entities to access immunization information in certain circumstances.
HB 1145 (Deferred from 29th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the payment of salary and compensation to legislators.
