- HB 1128\*      (Deferred from 30<sup>th</sup> LD) protect certain homestead exemption interests during sale of homestead or separation of owners.
- HB 1080\*      (Deferred from 30<sup>th</sup> LD) authorize the use of investigational treatments for patients under certain conditions and to restrict certain causes of action arising from investigational treatment.
