HB 1190* make an appropriation for community-based provider workforce improvement and to declare an emergency.

HB 1022 authorize the Board of Regents to purchase improved property in Spearfish and to make an appropriation therefor.

HB 1147 increase the amounts of the annual awards given to recipients of the South Dakota opportunity scholarship.

HB 1179 revise the definition of a veteran.

HB 1020* revise the mailing fees for noncommercial vehicle plates and decals.

HJR 1005 designating Oglala Lakota County as the new name of Shannon County.

HB 1169 accommodate legislation on medical services.

HB 1170 accommodate legislation relating to education in South Dakota.

HB 1171 enhance South Dakota.

HB 1176 authorize a person to be on the general election ballot for president or vice president and another office.

HB 1049 (Deferred from 31st LD) repeal certain provisions regarding reversions of appropriations for a repealed tax refund program.

HB 1059* (Deferred from 31st LD) allow authorized entities to access immunization information in certain circumstances.

HB 1047* (Deferred from 31st LD) revise certain reversion provisions relating to the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2013.

HB 1128* (Deferred from 31st LD) protect certain homestead exemption interests during sale of homestead or separation of owners.
