SB 60\* (Consideration of House Amendment; HJ 599) provide newborn screening of inherited and genetic disorders.

SB 120\* (Consideration of House Amendment; HJ 596, 597, 597, 619) ~~revise certain provisions regarding special alcoholic beverage licenses issued in conjunction with special events.~~  
revise certain provisions regarding special alcoholic beverage licenses issued in conjunction with special events and to declare an emergency.

SB 136\* (Consideration of House Amendment; HJ 618) ~~exclude municipal sales and use taxes from the gross receipts used to determine the tax liability of electric cooperatives.~~

HB 1231\* authorize the forfeiture of any financial benefit or valuables gained from pimping.

HB 1140\* increase the crimes and lookback period to enhance the penalty for violating a protection order.

HB 1015\* repeal certain provisions regarding the South Dakota Risk Pool.  
HB 1041 increase certain driver and commercial driver licensing application fees and to dedicate certain revenue for the purpose of operating the driver license program.  
HB 1046\* revise certain provisions regarding zero based budgets, budgeting procedures, and the coordination of federally aided programs.  
HJR 1002 making a formal application to the President of the United States, that the President grant a presidential pardon to Peter L. Larson.  
HB 1215\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) provide for an optional enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol.  
HB 1225\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) prohibit the unauthorized commercial use of a personality's right of publicity and provide a civil remedy therefor.  
HB 1190\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) make an appropriation for community-based provider workforce improvement and to declare an emergency.  
HB 1191\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) make an appropriation for the Jobs for America's Graduates program and to declare an emergency.  
HB 1147 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) increase the amounts of the annual awards given to recipients of the South Dakota opportunity scholarship.  
HB 1020\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) revise the mailing fees for noncommercial vehicle plates and decals.  
HB 1169 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) accommodate legislation on medical services.  
HB 1170 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) accommodate legislation relating to education in South Dakota.  
HB 1171 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) enhance South Dakota.  
HB 1049 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) repeal certain provisions regarding reversions of appropriations for a repealed tax refund program.  
HB 1047\* (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) revise certain reversion provisions relating to the General Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2013.
