LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY 2015

SENATE BILL NO. 129

AN ACT TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO TRESPASS ASSOCIATED WITH
HUNTING, FISHING, OR TRAPPING.

A prison/jail population cost estimate statement has been requested on SB129 due to the penalty in section 2.

SB 129 expands the violation of trespass to include trespassing while in route to a hunting, fishing, or trapping area for the purpose of hunting, fishing, or trapping. Since 2010, there have been 872 convictions of hunting trespass violations which have resulted in 2 jail days. Therefore, the number of violations may increase but the impact on prison or jail populations is likely to remain low.
