

PRISON/JAIL POPULATION COST ESTIMATE STATEMENT

NINETIETH SESSION

SENATE BILL NO. 187

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN RIGHTS OF PARENTS REGARDING THE
UPBRINGING, EDUCATION, HEALTH CARE, AND MENTAL HEALTH CARE OF THEIR
CHILDREN AND TO PROVIDE CERTAIN PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THOSE
RIGHTS.

A prison/jail population cost estimate statement has been requested on SB187
due to the penalties in sections 13 and 16.

The penalty in this Act is an administrative misdemeanor. Its purpose is to
enforce compliance with the provisions to which it adheres. This offense is not
likely to occur frequently. When this offense is prosecuted, it will not likely
result in a jail sentence. Hence, the impact on jail populations is negligible.
