History

Children's Care Hospital & School

Crippled Children's Hospital & School was established in 1952 in Sioux Falls, SD, as a grassroots effort by concerned citizens to provide rehabilitation and educational services to children recovering from polio. These children were treated in hospitals during the acute phase of their illness, and often never received further rehabilitation or returned to school, as buildings were seldom accessible.

By 1961, the polio vaccine had eliminated the disease in the United States. Meanwhile, other medical advances were saving more infants who were premature and had developmental challenges, and the hospital and school began serving more children with cerebral palsy and multiple disabilities. In the 1970s, the organization began serving children in their home communities through outreach programs, and in 1985, acquired an outpatient rehab facility in Rapid City. The name was changed to Children's Care Hospital & School in 1994. In 1999, a small specialty hospital unit was added in Sioux Falls, as well as an outpatient rehabilitation center. In 2012, Children's Care celebrated its 60th anniversary.

South Dakota Achieve

In 1958, 11 families in Sioux Falls began to seek out services for their children and others with intellectual disabilities, wanting them to have a chance at meaningful lives in their own community. The Sioux Chapter Workshop for the Mentally Retarded was formed and provided day services only. The name evolved to Sioux Vocational Services to reflect the organization's progression, and in 1969, residential services began. In 1975, integration occurred, and public schools started serving children with intellectual disabilities. Sioux Vocational then began specializing in supporting adults and older adolescents through residential, work, and volunteer services.

In 1979, Sioux Vocational became South Dakota's first agency to be nationally accredited, challenging it to be more responsive and innovative in its services. As a result, the agency became wheelchair accessible, offered retirement and other meaningful day opportunities, and focused on finding supported employment opportunities. It also launched specialized services for those with traumatic brain injuries and Autism Spectrum Disorders. In 2006, the name became South Dakota Achieve, and in 2013, the organization celebrated 55 years of service.

Services & Supports

Description

Medically Complex & Inpatient Rehabilitation

Intensive medical care and rehabilitation services for children with complex medical conditions or in need of rehabilitation following a serious injury, surgery, or accident.

Residential Services for Children & Young Adults

Comprehensive intensive services for children and adolescents with complex developmental, behavioral and intellectual disabilities, as well as co-occurring mental health or medical conditions.

Residential Services for Adults

Residential living options, including: Independent Living (in a home or apartment of choice); Supported Living (supports provided on a weekly basis); Supervised Apartments (daily supports); 24-hour Residential Living (supports provided 24 hours, 7 days/week). Options include specialized homes for people with TBI or autism.

Specialty School

Specialized learning environments that provide individualized educational services for children and adolescents with a broad range of intellectual disabilities, behavioral challenges, and medical needs.

Supported Employment

Vocational skills exploration/training, job coaching, and supported/independent employment opportunities.

Day Services

Opportunities for people to explore and experience a variety of meaningful activities during the day – recreation and leisure, meaningful relationships, new skills, volunteerism, and self-advocacy are examples.

Outpatient Therapy & Psychology Services

Highly specialized speech, occupational, and physical therapy evaluations and treatment; clinical psychology services; autism diagnosis & treatment; alternative and augmentative communication; sensory integration therapy; feeding and swallowing therapy; and incontinence training.

Rehabilitation Medical Supply – Orthotics, Prosthetics, & Mobility Solutions

Bracing and artificial limbs, as well as specialized rehabilitation equipment such as power and manual wheelchairs, walkers, and gait trainers – with customization if needed.


School-Based Outreach Therapy Services

School-based speech, occupational, and physical therapy provided to students in public school setting; as well as infants and toddlers at home or in daycares.

Family Support 360

A wide variety of specialized supports to help children with developmental disabilities to live with their loved ones – in their home. Some services include: service coordination, respite care, incontinence supplies, adaptive equipment, and home/vehicle modifications.





Level of Intellectual Disability






Children Supported in LifeScope ICF Residential Services


FY2011 Discharges (14 people)
