1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation for certain costs related to the
2 commissioning of the USS South Dakota and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred
5 thousand dollars (\$100,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of the
6 Military to support activities related to the commissioning of the USS South Dakota-SSN 790,
7 educate the people of South Dakota about the nuclear-powered submarine, and sponsor visits
8 of the submarine's crew to South Dakota.

9 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of the Military shall approve vouchers and the
10 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.



1 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
2 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

3 Section 4. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
4 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
5 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
