Amended HJ 12th LD: HB 1010 (Consent Calendar), HB 1086, HB 1092

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1011 repeal certain obsolete and unnecessary statutes concerning game preserves and refuges.
- HB 1071 revise certain provisions regarding the annual conference between county commissioners and the director of equalization.
- HB 1087 repeal the requirement of a certain public election notice.
- HB 1089 revise provisions for accumulation of funds for certain municipal enterprises.

- HB 1005* (Deferred from 12th LD; JR 5-17 with pending amendment; HJ 185) revise and repeal certain fees that are established to compensate counties for services provided by county officials.
- HB 1069 (Deferred from 12th LD) revise certain provisions related to genetic counselor licensure.
- HB 1066* (Deferred from 12th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the public notice for a meeting of a public body.

- HB 1065 (Deferred from 12th LD) designate the Civilian Conservation Corps Museum of South Dakota in Hill City as the official Civilian Conservation Corps Museum of South Dakota.
- HB 1078 (Deferred from 12th LD) grant limited immunity from arrest and prosecution for certain alcohol related offenses to persons who assist a person in need of emergency assistance or who are themselves in need of emergency assistance.
- HB 1016 (Deferred from 12th LD) revise the authority granted to the Building Authority and to the Board of Regents to construct certain improvements at South Dakota State University in Brookings and the University of South Dakota in Vermillion.
- HB 1031* revise certain provisions pertaining to weights and measures.
- HB 1084* define when concurrent employment may be used to calculate earnings in workers' compensation cases.
- HB 1077* grant limited immunity from arrest and prosecution for certain related offenses to persons who assist certain persons in need of emergency assistance or who are themselves in need of emergency assistance.
- HB 1097 exempt certain taxes and fees from the gross receipts tax on telecommunications services.
- HB 1098 revise certain provisions regarding the exemption of motor vehicles from the motor vehicle excise tax.
