House Page Resolution 2

- HCR 1007 (HJ 15<sup>th</sup> LD) Requiring the use of sound science in evaluating crop protection chemistries and nutrients.
- HCR 1008 (HJ 15<sup>th</sup> LD) Urging Congress to support and to ask the United States Secretary of State to approve the Keystone XL Pipeline project.
- HCR 1009 (HJ 15<sup>th</sup> LD) Expressing the right of South Dakotans to own and use firearms.

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1102\* (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) allow for additional time to review certain competitive sealed bids.
- HB 1112\* establish certain procedures regarding a transgender policy for the purposes of participation in high school activities and to declare void any present transgender policy of the South Dakota High School Activities Association.
- HB 1107\* ensure government nondiscrimination in matters of religious beliefs and moral convictions.

- HB 1051 prohibit the use of certain automated sales suppression devices and to provide penalties for their use.
- HB 1150 revise certain provisions concerning the property tax exemption provided to local industrial development corporations.
- HB 1120 revise the definition of agricultural purposes used for the administration of the sales tax.
- HB 1151 require legislative approval of certain land acquisitions by the Department of Game, Fish and Parks.

## SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 10 (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the renovation and construction of an addition to Harding Hall on the campus of South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.
- SB 11 (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) authorize the Board of Regents to purchase land from the Dakota State University Foundation for the use and benefit of Dakota State University in Madison, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 17 (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation for costs related to suppression of wildfires in the state and to declare an emergency.
- SB 18 (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation from the coordinated natural resources conservation fund to the State Conservation Commission and to declare an emergency.
- SB 68 (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) make appropriations from the water and environment fund and its revolving fund subfunds for various water and environmental purposes, to revise solid waste management program recycling provisions, to revise water and environment fund loan terms, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 27 revise certain personnel requirements for ambulance services and to repeal the hardship exemption.
- SB 28 require meningococcal immunization for school entry.
- SB 2\* revise the distribution of the revenue from the alcoholic beverage fund.
- SB 12\* authorize the Board of Regents to sell certain extraneous real property in Brookings County and to deposit the proceeds with the state treasurer to be credited to a fund designated as the real property acquisition and capital improvement fund for South Dakota State University.
