SB 17 (Deferred from 28th LD) make an appropriation for costs related to suppression of wildfires in the state and to declare an emergency.

- SB 2* (Deferred from 28th LD) revise the distribution of the revenue from the alcoholic beverage fund.
- SB 34 (Deferred from 28th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the chemical testing of commercial drivers.
- SB 63* (Deferred from 28th LD) require the development of school safety plans and to require the conduct of school safety drills in accredited schools.
- SB 53* (Deferred from 28th LD) revise certain provisions concerning the bank franchise tax.
- SB 59 (Deferred from 28th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the application of the special annual road funding levy.
- SB 75* (Deferred from 28th LD) establish a grant program for adult community residential services designed to reduce the risk of recidivism, to provide a report to the Legislature, to make an appropriation therefor, and declare an emergency.
- SB 132* (Deferred from 28th LD) revise certain provisions regarding education funding.
- SB 23* (Deferred from 28th LD) extend the time allowed for conditional land exchanges.
- SB 58* (Deferred from 28th LD) revise certain restrictions for the use of night-vision equipment for hunting under certain conditions.
- SB 16* (Deferred from 28th LD) establish a fee for a nursery license and to increase fees for nursery inspection.
- SB 73 (Deferred from 28th LD) clarify certain provisions regarding open meetings.
- SB 81* (Deferred from 28th LD) create the paraprofessional tuition assistance scholarship program.
- SB 55 (Deferred from 28th LD) revise certain provisions relating to the HOPE probation program.
- SB 79* (Deferred from 28th LD) expand the list of professionals authorized to perform certain examinations required for a plea of guilty but mentally ill.
- SB 97* (Deferred from 28th LD) ~~provide for the automatic removal of all Class 2 misdemeanor convictions from background check records after ten years under certain conditions.~~
