MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HB 1141* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 426, 477) license persons offering applied behavior analysis services to the public.

HCR 1007* (Consideration of Senate Amendments; SJ 474) Requiring the use of sound science in evaluating crop protection chemistries and nutrients.

SB 22* add emergency medical technicians and paramedics to the list of mandatory reporters, and to update cross references in the section.

SB 107* clarify certain safety zone restrictions on hunting.

SB 116 remove any reference to land ownership being a requirement for participation in any actions pertaining to the creation of or withdrawal from a water development district.

SB 74 authorize members of certain governing bodies who are displaced by a natural disaster to continue their term of office.

HB 1029 make an appropriation to the Department of Health to fund the rural residency program and to declare an emergency.

- HB 1046 make an appropriation to the railroad trust fund and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1061* provide a tuition benefit to certain teachers who enroll in courses under the management and control of the Board of Regents that are not subsidized by the general fund.
- HB 1203 pay off bonds and make certain other changes necessary to effectuate a tuition freeze by the Board of Regents and the technical institutes, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.

- SB 58* (Deferred from 30th LD) revise certain restrictions for the use of night-vision equipment for hunting under certain conditions.
- SB 81* (Deferred from 30th LD) create the paraprofessional tuition assistance scholarship program.
- SB 55 (Deferred from 30th LD) revise certain provisions relating to the HOPE probation program.
- SB 79* (Deferred from 30th LD) expand the list of professionals authorized to perform certain examinations required for a plea of guilty but mentally ill.
- SB 97* (Deferred from 30th LD) ~~provide for the automatic removal of all Class 2 misdemeanor convictions from background check records after ten years under certain conditions:~~
provide for the automatic removal of all petty offenses, municipal ordinance violations, and Class 2 misdemeanor charges or convictions from background check records after ten years under certain conditions.
- SB 42* (Deferred from 30th LD) increase certain fees for boxing, kickboxing, and mixed martial arts competitions.
- SB 45* (Deferred from 30th LD) revise certain provisions of the building South Dakota fund programs.
- SB 5* (Deferred from 30th LD) revise the procedure to initiate a school district boundary change.
- SB 54* (Deferred from 30th LD) adopt the Elder Abuse Task Force's statutory recommendations in order to protect South Dakota seniors and adults with disabilities from abuse, neglect, and exploitation.
- SB 9* (Deferred from 30th LD) make an appropriation to fund the Native American achievement schools grant program and paraprofessional tuition assistance scholarship program.
- SB 50* (Deferred from 30th LD) revise the allocation of certain fees collected by the Department of Corrections.
- SB 150* (Deferred from 30th LD) ~~provide for additional interns for the minority party under certain circumstances:~~
revise provisions related to the legislative intern program.
- SB 3 (Deferred from 30th LD) revise the income criteria for determining if property is classified as agricultural land for property tax purposes.
- SB 80* (Deferred from 30th LD) limit certain liability for hosts of fishing tournaments.

- SB 2* (Deferred from 30th LD) revise the distribution of the revenue from the alcoholic beverage fund.
- SB 69* (Deferred from 30th LD) require accredited schools to accept transfer credits for courses taken by students from other accredited schools during the summer and to declare an emergency.
- SB 129* (Deferred from 30th LD) establish certain suicide awareness and prevention training requirements for certain school employees based on the Jason Flatt Act.
- SB 31 (Deferred from 30th LD) revise certain provisions regarding the sentencing and supervision of prison inmates and parolees with suspended sentences.
- SB 26* revise certain provisions concerning sex offender registration and to require an offender to notify of intended foreign travel.
- SB 133 revise certain provisions regarding shared services provided by the state to school districts, the sharing of services of school district employees, the classroom innovation grant program, and educator mentoring and certification reciprocity.
- SB 136 permit certain cropland along lakes, rivers, and streams to be assessed as noncropland.
- SB 148 authorize additional nursing facility beds for the Michael J. Fitzmaurice Veterans Home and to declare an emergency.
- SB 152 enact the Peter Falk Act to ensure visitation of certain protected persons.
- SB 90* ensure that members of the public are able to access and record public meetings.
