- SB 107\* (Removed from Consent Calendar) clarify certain safety zone restrictions on hunting.
- SB 2\* (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) revise the distribution of the revenue from the alcoholic beverage fund.
- SB 69\* (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) require accredited schools to accept transfer credits for courses taken by students from other accredited schools during the summer and to declare an emergency.
- SB 129\* (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) establish certain suicide awareness and prevention training requirements for certain school employees based on the Jason Flatt Act.
- SB 31 (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) revise certain provisions regarding the sentencing and supervision of prison inmates and parolees with suspended sentences.
- SB 26\* (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) revise certain provisions concerning sex offender registration and to require an offender to notify of intended foreign travel.
- SB 133 (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) revise certain provisions regarding shared services provided by the state to school districts, the sharing of services of school district employees, the classroom innovation grant program, and educator mentoring and certification reciprocity.
- SB 136 (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) permit certain cropland along lakes, rivers, and streams to be assessed as noncropland.
- SB 148 (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) authorize additional nursing facility beds for the Michael J. Fitzmaurice Veterans Home and to declare an emergency.
- SB 152 (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) enact the Peter Falk Act to ensure visitation of certain protected persons.
- SB 90\* (Deferred from 31<sup>st</sup> LD) ensure that members of the public are able to access and record public meetings.
- SB 131\* establish a target teacher salary and a target teacher ratio, to revise certain provisions regarding education funding, to create the School Finance Accountability Board, and to provide for certain school district reporting and penalties.
- SB 64\* revise the voting authority of an alderman.
- SB 65\* revise the procedure for a municipal recall petition.
- SB 72\* prohibit the abortion of an unborn child who is capable of experiencing pain and to provide a penalty therefor.
