SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 65* revise the procedure for a municipal recall petition.
- SB 10 authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the renovation and construction of an addition to Harding Hall on the campus of South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor.
- SB 11 authorize the Board of Regents to purchase land from the Dakota State University Foundation for the use and benefit of Dakota State University in Madison, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 17 make an appropriation for costs related to suppression of wildfires in the state and to declare an emergency.
- SB 18 make an appropriation from the coordinated natural resources conservation fund to the State Conservation Commission and to declare an emergency.
- SB 68 make appropriations from the water and environment fund and its revolving fund subfunds for various water and environmental purposes, to revise solid waste management program recycling provisions, to revise water and environment fund loan terms, and to declare an emergency.
- SB 24 prohibit the sale of fetal body parts and to provide a penalty therefor.
- SB 25 revise certain provisions concerning forfeiture of property interests of persons convicted of certain crimes.
- SB 54 adopt the Elder Abuse Task Force's statutory recommendations in order to protect South Dakota seniors and adults with disabilities from abuse, neglect, and exploitation.
- SB 76 revise certain codes and standards regarding wind energy system set back requirements.
- SB 34 (Removed from Consent Calendar) revise certain provisions regarding the chemical testing of commercial drivers.
- SB 82 establish the Native American achievement schools grant program.
- SB 3 revise the income criteria for determining if property is classified as agricultural land for property tax purposes.
- SB 63* (Removed from Consent Calendar) require the development of school safety plans and to require the conduct of lockdown drills in accredited schools.
- SB 5* (Deferred from 12th LD) revise the procedure to initiate a school district boundary change.
- SB 8* (Deferred from 12th LD) revise certain provisions regarding background investigations for prospective employees of the postsecondary technical institutes and to transfer certain funds regarding postsecondary technical credentialing.
