HB 1016 revise the authority granted to the Building Authority and to the Board of Regents to construct certain improvements at South Dakota State University in Brookings and the University of South Dakota in Vermillion.

HB 1035 revise and repeal certain provisions concerning voter registration, vote centers, and conducting elections.

HB 1052 (Deferred from 14<sup>th</sup> LD) revise certain alcoholic beverage business restrictions on Department of Revenue employees.

HB 1057 (Deferred from 14<sup>th</sup> LD) revise the rule-making authority of the South Dakota Commission on Gaming.

HB 1055 (Deferred from 14<sup>th</sup> LD) clarify that a gift of real property does not require a disclosure statement.

HB 1058\* (Deferred from 14<sup>th</sup> LD) revise the procedure for recovery of abandoned mineral interests.
