HCR 1011 (Deferred from 20th LD) (HJ p 320) Opposing the recent actions of the EPA and the President with regards to the Waters of the United States federal rule and applauding the South Dakota congressional delegates who opposed such actions.

HCR 1012 (HJ p 343) Requesting the South Dakota congressional delegation to introduce legislation to compensate private landowners for fire damage caused by the United States Forest Service.

SB 98 revise and repeal certain provisions regarding pork production.

SB 136 permit certain cropland along lakes, rivers, and streams to be assessed as noncropland.

SB 159* (Deferred from 20th LD) provide a tax credit to insurance companies that contribute to an organization providing educational scholarships to certain students.

SB 107 (Deferred from 20th LD) clarify certain safety zone restrictions on hunting.
