SB 129* establish certain suicide awareness and prevention training requirements for certain school employees based on the Jason Flatt Act.

- SB 75* establish a grant program for adult community residential services designed to reduce the risk of recidivism, to provide a report to the Legislature, to make an appropriation therefor, and declare an emergency.
- SB 97* ~~provide for the automatic removal of all Class 2 misdemeanor convictions from background check records after ten years under certain conditions:~~
provide for the automatic removal of all petty offenses, municipal ordinance violations, and Class 2 misdemeanor convictions from background check records after ten years under certain conditions.
- SB 140* eliminate life sentences for defendants under the age of eighteen at the time of the crime.
- SB 132 revise certain provisions regarding education funding.
