- HB 1190\* (Removed from Consent Calendar; S 6-1) enhance customer convenience in firearms transactions, improve public safety, and provide for the issuance of an additional concealed pistol permit.
- HB 1218\* (Removed from Consent Calendar) require certain notice procedures for any revision of municipal ordinances.
- HB 1118 limit the amount of instructional time that may be spent administering statewide academic assessments.
- HB 1146 authorize the Governor to enter agreements with Indian tribes regarding the high school equivalency tests administered on Indian reservations.
- HB 1029 make an appropriation to the Department of Health to fund the rural residency program and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1046 make an appropriation to the railroad trust fund and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1061\* provide a tuition benefit to certain teachers who enroll in courses under the management and control of the Board of Regents that are not subsidized by the general fund.
- HB 1203 pay off bonds and make certain other changes necessary to effectuate a tuition freeze by the Board of Regents and the technical institutes, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1078 grant limited immunity from arrest and prosecution for certain alcohol related offenses to persons who assist a person in need of emergency assistance or who are themselves in need of emergency assistance.
- HB 1110 (Deferred from 32 LD) provide medical care for certain unborn children.
- HB 1079\* (Deferred from 32 LD) permit the prescription and possession of an opioid antagonist in certain instances.
- HB 1157\* (Deferred from 32 LD) require that a doctor provide a woman additional information as a part of informed consent prior to performing an abortion.

- HB 1005\* (Deferred from 32 LD) revise and repeal certain fees that are established to compensate counties for services provided by county officials.
- HB 1043 (Deferred from 32 LD) revise the state aid to special education formula.
- HB 1044 (Deferred from 32 LD) revise the state aid to general education formula.
- HB 1143 (Deferred from 32 LD) accommodate legislation on medical services.
- HB 1144 (Deferred from 32 LD) enhance South Dakota.
- HB 1145 (Deferred from 32 LD) accommodate legislation relating to education in South Dakota.
