HB 1212* revise requirements related to pregnancy help centers
HB 1244 (Removed from Consent Calendar) revise provisions related to the sex offender registry
HB 1005* (Deferred from 33rd LD) revise and repeal certain fees that are established to compensate counties for services provided by county officials.
HB 1079* (Deferred from 33rd LD) permit the prescription and possession of an opioid antagonist in certain instances.
HB 1043 (Deferred from 33rd LD) revise the state aid to special education formula.
HB 1044 (Deferred from 33rd LD) revise the state aid to general education formula.
HB 1143 (Deferred from 33rd LD) accommodate legislation on medical services.
HB 1144 (Deferred from 33rd LD) enhance South Dakota.
HB 1145 (Deferred from 33rd LD) accommodate legislation relating to education in South Dakota.
