AMENDMENT NO. 1230fb

**AN ACT TO APPLY CERTAIN PROVISIONS REGARDING THE OPERATION OF
VEHICLES ON THE HIGHWAYS TO ANIMAL-DRAWN VEHICLES.**

A prison or jail population impact statement has been requested on HB1230 due to the creation of a Class 2 misdemeanor in amendment 1230fb. Section 1 of the amendment creates a new section to chapter 32-17 which makes it a Class 2 misdemeanor for any animal-drawn vehicle operating on a highway with insufficient light to be equipped with a flashing amber light visible from the front of the vehicle and a red flashing light visible from the rear of the vehicle.

The penalty in this amendment is a Class 2 misdemeanor. Its purpose is to enforce compliance with the provisions to which it adheres. This offense could be prosecuted. However, if prosecuted, it will not likely result in a prison or jail sentence. Hence, the impact on prison or jail populations is negligible.
