[SB 93](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) revise the uniform commercial code.

[SB 97\\*](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) revise certain provisions regarding property condition disclosure statements.

[SB 177](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) revise certain provisions regarding the disposal of abandoned tenant's property left on leased residential premises.

[SB 29](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation to fund a dental externship program.

[SB 47](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation for costs related to disasters in the state and to declare an emergency.

[SB 49\\*](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation for costs related to suppression of wildfires in the state and to declare an emergency.

[SB 55](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) authorize the Board of Regents to convey a tract of land in Pennington County to the United States Air Force and to declare an emergency.

[SB 40\\*](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) establish certain requirements regarding the separation and protection of a gas and electric public utility's assets.

[SB 148](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) provide for a tax incentive for fuel blended with biodiesel.

[SB 37](#) (Deferred from 27<sup>th</sup> LD) establish certain suitability requirements for annuities.
