1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding suspension or 2 debarment of a business by the Bureau of Administration. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 5-18D-12 be amended to read: 5 5-18D-12. The Bureau of Administration, after notice to the business involved, may suspend 6 or debar a business for cause from consideration of any state contracts contract. The suspension 7 may not exceed three six months and the debarment may not exceed three years. Any action to 8 debar or suspend shall be conducted by the Bureau of Administration bureau pursuant to chapter 9 1-26. A business shall exhaust each administrative remedy before commencing any action to 10 challenge a debarment or suspension. 11 Suspension or debarment may be imposed for: 12 (1) The criminal conviction of or civil judgment against a business or principal, officer, 13 director, or manager of the business involving fraud or dishonesty; 14 (2) Willful failure or a history of failure to perform in accordance with the terms of one 15 or more government contracts or transactions;
