Proclamation Convening the Legislature
In Special Session During the Year 2018


Whereas, Article IV, Section 3 of the South Dakota Constitution authorizes the Governor to convene special sessions of the South Dakota Legislature by Executive Proclamation for the purpose stated in the proclamation; and

Whereas, the Governor deems it necessary and appropriate to convene a special session of the South Dakota Legislature for the important public purpose described herein;

Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim a special session of the South Dakota Legislature will be convened in the chambers of the Senate and the House of Representatives at the Capitol in the City of Pierre, South Dakota, on Wednesday, the Twelfth day of September, 2018, at 10 a.m. central daylight savings time. The members of the Ninety-Third Legislature are called to the Capitol to attend such special session to adopt or amend laws, to approve resolutions, and to take such action as the Legislature deems, in its collective judgment, necessary to satisfy the purposes specified in this proclamation.

The purpose of the special session is to consider legislation relating to two issues. First, the collection and remittance of sales tax by remote sellers. And secondly, the timeframe by which state officers can enter into office.
