FILINGS IN THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COUNCIL'S OFFICE:

NOTICE:

The **Department of Social Services**, in conjunction with the **Department of Human Services**, intends to renew the CHOICES 1915 (c) HCBS Waiver. The CHOICES Waiver is operated by the Division of Developmental Disabilities in the South Dakota Department of Human Services. The proposed waiver renewal adjusts the corresponding waiver appendices and is a result of federal regulations requiring renewal of the waiver every five years. The renewal modifies Appendix A, B, C, D, F, G, H, I, and J, and Subsections A2b, Aaii, Abi, B3a, B6f, B6i, Ba, Baii, Bbi, C1a, C2a, C2f, Ccii, D1c, D1d, D1e, Deii, Dbi, F1, F3b, G1b, G1d, G2ai, G2bii, G3bii, G3civ, H1ai, H1bi, Iaii, I2a, J2, and J2d of the CHOICES Waiver. The Department proposes to make this amendment effective June 1, 2018. A waiver renewal summary document can be located at the Department of Human Services/Division of Developmental Disabilities website: <http://dhs.sd.gov/developmentaldisabilities/default.aspx>. Significant changes to the waiver include revising the Case Management definition to include Transition Case Management; renaming Prevocational Services to Career Exploration; adding Shared Living to Residential Habilitation; and adding Group Supported Employment to the Supported Employment definition. The Department of Human Services anticipates there will be no

federal fiscal impact associated with the waiver renewal. Copies of the proposed waiver renewal and public input schedules are available at the Department of Social Services, Division of Medical Services. REMINDER OF HEARINGS SCHEDULED

1-11-2018	Department of Game, Fish and Parks: Amend rules to modify the Low Plains South Zone hunting season to begin on the third Saturday instead of the second Saturday; increase the pigtail bag limit from one to two; remove Lawrence and Meade Counties from Unit 1 and place them in Unit 2 for the Canada goose hunting season and allow goose hunting into mid-February; and reduce the daily limit from fifteen to eight birds and change the possession limit from forty-five to three times the daily limit of Canada geese; 44 SDR 111, December 27, 2017.
