NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council)

Department of Education: South Dakota Board of Education: (January 5, 2004) has filed rules to move the implementation date of a curriculum rule back one year; to enable an individual licensed as a clinical psychologist to administer and interpret individual student psychological evaluations as long as he or she is employed by a psychiatric residential facility; to allow any coursework, renewal or college transcripted, that a teacher completes by January 1, 2004, toward his or her next renewal to be honored; to create rules for an alternative route to certification specific to the Teach for America program, rather than requiring candidates for the program to have completed a bachelors degree two years prior to applying; and to create rules that define certification for social workers. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 13-1-12.1, 13-3-47, 13-3-55, 13-3-56, 13-37-1.1, and 13-42-3.

A public hearing will be held in conference

rooms one and two of the Kneip Building, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota, on January 26, 2004, at 9:45 a.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the Department of Education, South Dakota Board of Education, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Written comments must be received by January 26, 2004, to be considered. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
