***Department of Education and Cultural***

***Affairs: Board of Education:*** (January 7, 2003)

intends to amend rules regarding the requirement of three mathematics credits for high school graduation and the allowance for graduation credit to be given to students who complete Algebra I in eighth grade and successfully pass a state-designated Algebra I assessment and adopt a rule requiring that high school student transcripts contain evidence that all parts of the grade 11 state-designated assessment was successfully completed prior to graduation. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 13-1-12.1, 13-3-47, 13-3-55, and 13-3-56.

A public hearing will be held in the conference room of the South Dakota Education Association, 411 E. ***Affairs: Board of Education:*** (January 7, 2003)

intends to repeal rules for the defunct Congressional Teacher Scholarship Program

and amend rules to clarify definitions and criteria and alignment of the number of awards with the size of the eligible applicant pool in each federal district court division in South Dakota for the Robert Byrd Honors Scholarship program. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 13-14-1.
