NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council)

Department of Environment and Natural Resources: Board of Water and Natural Resources: (January 10, 2002) intends to adopt rules to change the name of the Mid Dakota and Southern Missouri water development districts to Central Plains and South Central, respectively, add two directors to the West Dakota water development district, and redistrict the director areas of all seven water development districts. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 46A-3C-6.

A public hearing will be held over the Dakota Digital Network (DDN) on Thursday, January 31, 2002, at 11:00 a.m. CST. The following DDN sites will be available: Aberdeen – Northern State University, Beulah Williams Library, Room 117, 1200 South Jay Street; Pierre - State Capitol, Studio A, Room B12, 500 East Capitol Avenue; Rapid City - Rapid City Regional Hospital, Educational Services Department, 353 Fairmont Boulevard; Sioux Falls - Southeast Technical Institute, Mickelson Building, Room 205, 2301 Career Place; Vermillion - USD Center for Continuing Education, Studio I, Room 118A, 414 East Clark; and Watertown - Lake Area Technical Institute, Main Building, Room 125, 230 11th Street NE. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Board of Water and Natural Resources, 523 East Capitol Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Written comments must be received by January 30, 2002, to be considered.

Executive Order

Executive Order 2002-1, dated January 10, 2002, creates the Committee on Reasonable Child Custody and Visitation. The Committee will make recommendations to the 2002 Legislature regarding laws to improve the well-being of children during and after divorce proceedings. The Committee will be administered by the Governor's Office.
